With the release of in-line patch 1 (Build:1.832xRT03), users can have the printer output at the R> prompt their way!

Here is how to customize your printer output at the R> prompt:

**Steps:**

01. Launch R:BASE 2000 (ver 6.5) for Windows

02. Make sure that you are using the right version.

At the mighty R> prompt, type:

SHOW VERSION

It should display the version as the following:

R:BASE 2000 (version 6.5) Windows (32-bit), U.S. Version, Build: 1.832xRT03

03. If you are not using the right version, please download the latest in-line patch from:

<http://www.rbase2000.com/Updates>

04. Click on Utilities

05. Click on Preferences

06. Click on [Printer] push button under Default Fonts:

07. If you would like the output similar to R:BASE 6.1A, then, select:

Font: Terminal  
Font Style: Regular  
Size: 12  
Script: OEM/DOS (optional)

OR

You can select any combination you like. Have it your way!

08. Click on [OK] to save changes.

All settings are saved under [RPOutputDefaultFont] in R:BASE 2000 (ver 6.5) RBASE.INI file.
